

Rules of procedure

Participation to the lecture implies accepting and respecting the following rules of procedure:

1. No interrupting the speaker;
2. The main language is English. If you don't feel comfortable you can write the comment in the chat and the moderator will translate it in the end. Will be addressed at the end of the lecture;
3. Violent or offensive comments will not be entertained;
4. No individual accusations of criminal acts;
5. No victim blaming, very very important.

The fundamental principles of communication are empathy and mutual respect. Offensive language will not be tolerated. Depending on the statements made by the participant, the moderator has the right to interrupt, mute and end the participation of the individual to the lecture. The moderator takes the executive decision on appropriate action, her decisions are non-debatable and non-negotiable.
